STARTING A PARISH NURSE PROGRAM IN YOUR CONGREGATION

Do you know that over 500 registered nurses are participating in Parish Nurse Programs in more than 200 parishes/congregations here in Connecticut? I would like to extend this program to even more parishes and I ask you to consider your own church as a possibility.

The Parish Nurse Program (also called "Faith Community Nursing") was founded by a Lutheran Pastor Rev. Granger Westberg in the early 1980's and has spread throughout the U.S., Canada and other countries.

The nurse works together with other healthcare providers and lay persons in the church to develop a health ministry program that addresses all facets of health and wellness. There is room for all who feel called to participate in this wonderful ministry.

The focus of the Parish Nurse program is on maintaining a healthy balance of mind, body and spirit. The Parish Nurse serves as Health Educator, Health Counselor, Referral Source and Health Promoter. Through such basic services as monthly Blood Pressure screenings, the nurse is able to provide valuable instruction and assistance to the members of his/her own congregation. As a result, many parishioners unaware of existing health problems have been referred to their personal physicians before a serious problem evolves. There are also opportunities to do community outreach.

Our program at St. Vincent's has been in existence since 1992 and we now have over 80 parishes extending across Fairfield County. I provide an orientation program for new parish nurses, and am available to assist in any way I can to set up a program in your church.

I would love to meet with any nurses, physicians, EMT's social workers, etc. who are interested in beginning a health ministry program at Fairfield Grace UMC. I invite anyone who wants to learn more about the program to attend the meeting as well.


