## A Message from Pastor Cho:

# SUSANNA'S CIRCLE

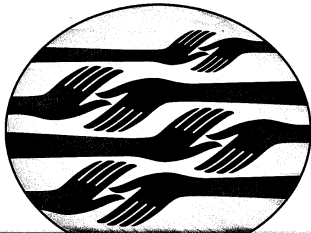
## LADIES:

12/20 - Pageant Day (Arrive at 9:30am dressed and ready to go)

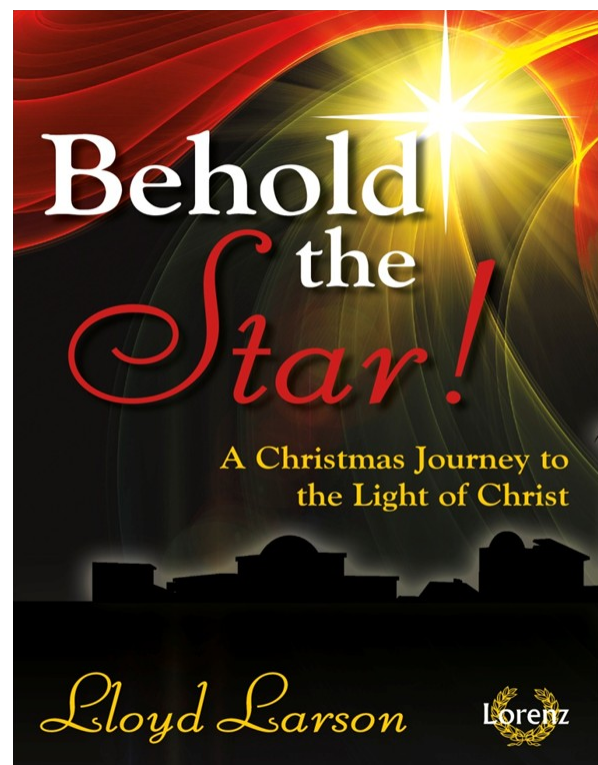

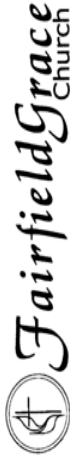

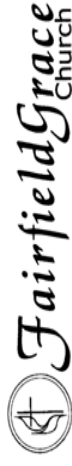
