## ***A Message From Our Pastor...***

---

Dear my FGUMC family and friends,

***“Very truly I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds. Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life. (John 12:24-26)***

It is Monday morning. The words Jesus spoke yesterday in the Sanctuary are still ringing in my ears. Do you remember one of the many paradoxical lesson taught yesterday? “It is only in giving that you receive.” “If you want to be first, you must become last.” “If you’re going to be master, you must become a servant.” And all of those paradoxes are wrapped up in one: You must die if you want to live. It is the heart of Jesus’ call. No death, no resurrection. No dying, no new beginning. I am reminded of another command Jesus gave to his disciples on the way to Calvary. ***“Deny yourself and carry your own cross, if you want to follow me.”*** Do you know why someone carries a cross? Not to show off his or her strength. Obviously, he or she carries a cross to die on it. So let me paraphrase what he said: “Die to your ego. Die to your pride. Die to your selfishness, or you cannot be my disciple and cannot have a new life with me, which is eternal life.” Do we intend to follow him? If so, then are we willing to die? Are you? Am I? Paul said, “I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who lives but Christ who lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.”(Galatians 2:20) May the sanctifying grace of God lead us to the cross and enable us to live the resurrection life with Christ.

***“Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me.”*** (John 12:26) We know what following Jesus means. It means that we serve him by serving others. Do we intend to follow Jesus? If so, then we must serve, period. Parents serve children and children parents. Husbands serve wives and wives husbands. Teachers serve students and students teachers. Pastors serves people and people pastors. Yes, we are called to be the church to love and serve others. John Wesley wrote to his Methodist sisters and brothers the following Rule of Conduct: “Do all the good you can, By all the means you can, In all the ways you can, In all the places you can, At all the times you can, To all the people you can, As long as ever you can.” It is the rule for our Christian conduct as long as we shall live.






